

## QN25UM

- 25" Undermount system
- Allows easy undermount installation of all Allia kitchen and bar/food prep sinks
- Adjusts to fit cabinet size, can be cut down to size
- Leveling bolts included
- Use with granite or solid surface countertop materials
- No need for wood supports
- Removable
- Not designed for UM3018 sink
- Must order two units to undermount 6737 sink
- Made of aluminum




## QN25UM & QN36UM Istallation Instructions


Identify parts.

This pack includes:

- a) 25", 36", or 50" rail (2 each)
- b) Mounting clips (4 each)
- c) 2" adjusting bolts (8 each)
- d) Nuts (8 each)
- e) Plastic bolt caps (8 each)
- f) Wood screws (8 each)
- g) Joiner clips (2 each)
  For ovals and rounds, 2 sets required.
  (See Drawing 1A) Discard if not using.




If needed, cut (with hacksaw) the Undermounter rails 3/8" less than the length of the inside of the cabinet. (For round and oval installations: cut 2nd set of rails the necessary distance between the 1st set.)





Determine exact location where Undermounter is to be installed in cabinet. Make sure Undermounter adjustment bolts come into contact with the underside of the sink ledge. Determine exact location where mounting clips will be installed. Mark on cabinet frame where holes in clip are located. Drill starter holes where marked.

\*Note: Depending upon fabrication of countertop, top of mounting clip may need to be notched into top of cabinet frame.



Two Undermounter packages are needed for ovals and rounds.

- **5** Screw mounting clips to sides of cabinet frame.
- 6 Lower rail onto mounting clip arms. Use either arm depending upon the thickness of the sink ledge.

\*Note: If rail is to be installed on lower arms, it may be necessary to cut off the top arm to avoid interference with the sink.

- Slip bolt caps onto end of bolts.
- 8 Carefully lower the sink onto the Undermounter.
- **9** Use adjustment bolts to raise and level the sink flush with the underside of the countertop.

\*Note: Caulk should be used where sink comes into contact with underside of the countertop.
